I am recovering from a shocking chest infection that has laid low my whole family. Schools are great places to catch just about any disease and that is why we always ask parents to keep sick children home when their children are unwell. According to the authorities, this is the worse flu season in many years so please support the school, the teachers and your child's classmates by making sure your child is fit and healthy enough to go to school.

By now if your child is in Grade 3 or 5 you would have received your child's NAPLAN results in the mail. Just remember NAPLAN is just a snapshot of how your child performed on a particular day on a particular test; it is not a comprehensive statement of how your child is progressing at school. That is why our teachers use a number of different testing measures to accurately plot your child's progress and growth. If you were concerned, by anything you found in the NAPLAN results or simply have questions, please speak to your child's teacher.

Once again, too many children are getting to school before 8.45AM when we start yard duty. If a parent wants to sit with their child until the yard duty teacher arrives, that is fine. Kelly Club runs through until 8.45AM so again, it is a cheap, safe and secure way to ensure that your children are looked after by qualified workers prior to the school resuming our duty at 8.45AM.

If you have a younger child who is due to start school in 2018 or if you have neighbours or friends who have yet to speak with the school about enrolment, please do so or get them to do so soon. We are planning for 2018 and this means deciding what classes are going to run in 2018 and what staff we will need for the number of students we expect to have at Dinjerra in 2018. We need accurate figures.


