Principal Report

You may have noticed that the first concrete slab has been poured on the building site. It is the slab that the new learning-centre classrooms will be built on. The second slab will be poured very soon and that will support the administration area of the school. There has been a problem out front near the car park gates because where the builders thought they could attach the gas, water and the storm water to the mains but there were Telstra cables there making it impossible. They are still seeking a solution to that one. The current hand over time for the new school is mid to late December 2019 meaning that we will most likely move during Term 1, 2020.

School Council elections are currently underway with voting closing at 4.00PM on 2/03/2019. All votes posted before the close of voting will be counted. We sent a voting slip to every parent along with two envelopes, one to put the voting slip into once filled out, and a second one, addressed to the school, that the voting envelope is placed inside. It is important that you follow the instructions fully to ensure that your vote is valid and able to be counted. All candidates were asked to write a short piece about why they wanted to be on Council and the ones we got back were included in the letter we sent to you. As the key policy making group in the school, it is very important that parents are represented.

Unfortunately, I must ask parents to stop using the staff car park for dropping off or picking up their children. There is not enough room and we don't want children walking through the car park for reasons of safety. Exceptions to this are parents picking up or dropping off their children at Kelly Club or parents with a child who is physically disabled or sick or injured making walking difficult. Unrestricted parking is available opposite the school in West Central Park Ave. and on our side of South Road in Melon Street and Garden Drive. Your children can meet you at a pre-arranged site or you can come to your child's classroom and wait until they are dismissed.
