HAPPY HARMONY WEEK! Harmony Week is a significant celebration for Dinjerra, as we are made up of many different cultural backgrounds. Embracing each other's differences and cultural practices is important for all of our school community, because it is important for us to learn about what is valued by others. Did you know that at Dinjerra with 215 student enrolments:

- We have over 104 students that speak a language other than English at home (48/%)
- 58 of these students were born in Australia, but speak another language at home (27%)





A free trail at Footscray Hockey Club has been offered to any students keen on pursuing the sport, so please pay them a visit if you enjoyed the clinic!



STEM NEWS

In STEM, as part of our chemical sciences focus, Grade 5/6 students have been exploring a range of reversible and irreversible changes, including chemical reactions. Students observed the 'whoosh bottle experiment', where flammable liquid is ignited in a large bottle resulting in an exciting combustion that changes the liquid to water. Students then conducted their own experiments to separate dissolved solids from liquids.

We have an excellent example of work from Huey Norriss where he wrote the best ways to show full body listening in Spanish class.



ART NEWS

What an incredible term it has been in the art room! Across all year levels, we have been exploring some of the Elements of Art, focusing on Shape, Line, and Colour. Students have experimented with different techniques, materials, and creative processes, producing some truly impressive work.

Our youngest artists in Prep have been developing their fine motor skills through cutting, gluing, and working with shapes, while the Year 1/2 students explored line in a fun and expressive way, creating scribble chickens with a colour wash. They also had a blast making blow ink "colour monsters," watching how colours mix and move in unexpected ways. In Year 3/4, students experimented with wax-resist techniques, layering oil pastels and watercolours to reveal hidden patterns and textures.

The creativity continued in Year 5/6 with a mix of digital and traditional art. Students created portrait collages, blending photography with words that represent their personality. They also explored composition through three-line drawings, proving that even the simplest elements can create striking artwork. Another exciting project saw students using solar printing techniques, placing natural objects onto light-sensitive paper to create beautiful sun-exposed prints.

As we head toward the end of term, colour is becoming a major focus in the art room, and I can't wait to see how students continue to experiment and create. It's been an inspiring term, and I feel so lucky to be part of their artistic journey.














